**Annual Membership Program-**Annual membership is a great way for individuals to pledge their continued support.

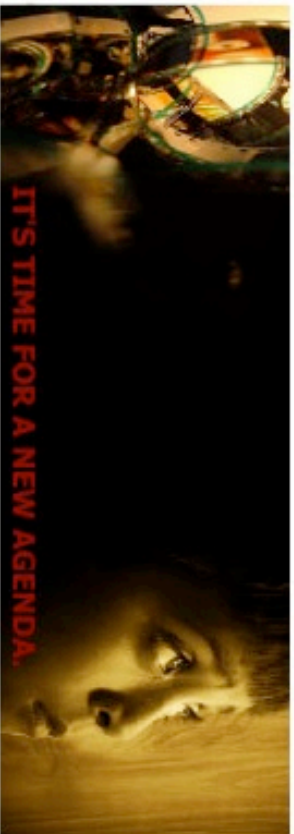

- 65% of emancipated foster youth leave the system with no place to go
- In California over 70% of all state penitentiary inmates have spent some time in foster care.
- In Los Angeles 50% of emancipated youth will be homeless within six months of exiting the foster care system.
- 50% of females receive some form of welfare within 1-6 years of emancipation
- Only 18% of youth who have exited foster care have maintained employment for at least 1 year
- Half of emancipated foster women had been pregnant at least once by the age of 19
- Emancipated foster youth earn an average of \$6,000 per year.

Founded in 2007 by Kaylene Peoples, Agenda Foundation is organization. The foundation's primary focus is to offer Los Angeles area foster youth an outlet to express their thoughts, feelings and perceptions of their world through film making.

Agenda's programs and services are a direct response to the lack of creative outlets for foster youth. Through an intensive film making education program, Agenda will introduce young men and women to the art of film making.



### **Mission**

The mission of Agenda Foundation is to enhance the quality of life for youth in foster care by providing them with the opportunity to express them through filmmaking. Inherent in this mission is Agenda Foundation's responsibility to reshape distorted images of society by providing socially conscious filmmaking.

To use filmmaking as a tool that will provide foster youth with transferable skills they can use to live healthy and productive lives.

## Young Filmmakers Project

Agenda students participate in a comprehensive film making program that is guided by a customized curriculum. The Young Film Makers Project is for youth 13 to 18 years old. It will provide participants with information and education in the areas of film making which includes:

1. **Equipment Operation**
2. **Pre-Production**
3. **Script Development**
4. **Production/Post production**
5. **Marketing**

The Young Film Makers Project is more than a filmmaking initiative. It will provide training and education that will create transferable skills to youth as they age out of the foster care system. Skills that will assist participants in their quest in accessing higher education, greater employment and life opportunities.
